Travel to Red Bay National Historic Site and stay at ***Whaler's Restaurant and Cabins***. Unique 2 ½ star refurbished merchant premises in the heart of the historic Red Bay providing full service dining, overnight accommodations and a full range of crafts and souvenirs.

Suggested Itinerary for visitors to the Labrador Straits.

Day 1: Visit Gateway to Labrador in L'Anse-au-Clair, a restored turn-of-the-century church, for information about the people and places locals know best. Climb the 128 steps of the tallest lighthouse in Atlantic Canada overlooking Iceberg Alley and view the wreckage of the British warship, HMS Raleigh at Point Amour Lighthouse Provincial Historic Site. Watch for whales, seabirds and icebergs aboard our ferries or from numerous places along the coast or hike the Pioneer Footpath with guides from Labrador Adventures. Overnight at the Whaler's Cabins.

Day 2: Discover the unique 16th-century story of oil production for the lamps of Europe at Red Bay National Historic Site of Canada. Go geocaching on Tracey Hill or snap some pictures of icebergs and whales as you explore the many historic and community hiking trails for splendid views of the land and sea, and a look at nature close-up. Retreat to Whaler's Restaurant for a seafood meal and overnight at the Whaler's Cabins.

Day 3: Continue your journey along the Labrador Coastal Drive Route 510.
